### Key Stage 4

#### **Bienvenue!**

The French GCSE specification is based on a conviction that learners studying a modern foreign language will develop their desire and ability to communicate with and understand speakers of French in a variety of contexts and for a variety of purposes. The aim of studying a modern foreign language is to broaden horizons, develop cultural knowledge and understanding and foster transferable skills such as confidence, communication, problem solving and creativity.

GCSE MFL is organised into 3 broad themes:

- Identity and Culture
- Wales and the World – areas of interest
- Current and Future Study and Employment

#### **Unit 1: Speaking 25%**

3 tasks: role play, photo card discussion and conversation part 1 and part 2

#### **Unit 2: Listening 25%**

Listening comprehension tasks with non-verbal and written responses.

#### **Unit 3: Reading 25%**

Reading tasks with non-verbal and written responses, including one translation task from French into English.

#### **Unit 4: Writing 25%**

Written tasks including one translation task from English into French.
