



Dear Parent(s)

I wanted to write to you and clarify the situation for next week (w/c March 30th).

From next Monday, Mary Immaculate will not be open. We are combining with all the other faith schools in Cardiff, along with the Welsh Schools to be based at Glantaf School. This support is only for the parents who are key workers and need to be in work – as before it is also considered as a last resort to help these workers. **You must let us know urgently if you intend to use this facility.**

The provision will be at **Glantaf School** (Bridge Road, Llandaff North, Cardiff, CF14 2JL) for all eight schools. It will run from **8am to 5pm, 5 days a week, including holidays** (but not the Easter Bank Holiday). It will run throughout the normal Easter holidays.

There will be no school transport, so you will need to drop off and collect your son/daughter at Glantaf. There is no need for pupils to wear school uniform.

On site, there will be various activities from sport to learning, all supervised by staff from all of the eight schools involved. Breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack will be served at the school. Members of senior staff from all the schools will also be present.

I appreciate this is an unusual situation but all of our schools want to do our part in supporting the Health Service and other key workers at this time and supporting their children is an important role.

I also want to thank all of our parents for their support and kind words over the last week or so as we all struggle with this situation. We are still here to support you and our community and my staff and Governors have asked me to pass on their prayers and thoughts to all of you.
